NASSBT TOURNAMENT RULES

This Tournament is a scratch tournament sanctioned by the USBC.

- 1. REQUIREMENTS** - You must be at least 60 years of age for males and 50 years of age for females. Regular PBA National title holders or current PBA members are ineligible to bowl in this tournament.
- 2. FEES** – An annual membership fee is \$25.00 due by your fourth tournament. Entry fee for this tournament will be \$100.00 (\$5.00 from each entry will be applied to the December Year End prize fund). The December entry fee will be \$125.00 There is a \$35.00 charge for a bad check plus bank fees
- 3. YEAR END TOURNAMENT QUALIFICATION** – To be eligible to bowl in the Year End Tournament you must bowl in a minimum of 3 tournaments during the year.
- 4. QUALIFYING FORMAT** – This tournament consists of 5 games of qualifying, moving pairs of lanes after each game. Should a tie occur after 5 games of qualifying, a 9th & 10th frame roll-off will determine the winner. If another tie occurs, the process will be repeated until a winner emerges. The 9th & 10th frame roll off will be conducted on a pair of lanes neither bowler finished their qualifying on.
- 5. SCORING CHANGES** – Only by Tournament Director or Center staff member. All participants will be responsible for their own re-cap sheets and submitting them to the tournament office. Any incorrect scores recorded on your re-cap will be subject to disqualification. All scores will be verified by another bowler crossing on your pair of lanes with you.
- 6. NO CHEATING** – Automatic disqualification and reported to USBC. Subject to lifetime ban.
- 7. DRESS CODE** – Present yourself professionally. Dress slacks, shorts, capri pants, skirts, skorts. NO denim jeans, cutoffs, tank tops, or sweats. A shirt with your name on the back is REQUIRED, It helps me find you.
- 8. EQUIPMENT** – All bowling equipment and accessories must be USBC approved.
- 9. APPRECIATION** – Show respect to each host center. Any issues with lane conditions or the center in general, bring your issue to me NOT to the center or their staff.
- 10. RE-RACKS** – 2 re-racks are allowed per game. More than that requires director's approval.
- 11. CHECK-IN** - Begins at 8:30 A.M. Late entries allowed until start of bowling. Starting Lane assignments are drawn at the time of entry. A member meeting will be conducted at 9:45 A.M. in a designated area. At 10:00 A.M. bowling begins with 15 minutes of practice on your starting lanes.
- 12. ACCEPTANCE** – NASSBT Reserves the right to accept or reject anyone from membership in their organization, or participating as a non-member.
- 13. RULES** – Governed by USBC rules. The Tournament Director has final say on all disputes & interpretations.
